2 AGE VERIFICATION WRISTBANDS

Age Verification wristbands will expire each day. Get your day started by getting a new band by the Full Moon Saloon. 18+ wristbands are needed for Full Moon Saloon access.

3 WEAR YOUR WRISTBANDS AT ALL TIMES

If you don't have your festival wristband on we'll have to send ya' packing.

4. IF YOU DRINK, DRINK RESPONSIBLY

We want everyone to have a safe experience. Don't drink and drive. The Nevada Highway Patrol will be conducting DUI checkpoints throughout the festival.

5 HYDRATE Y'ALL!

Don't let the sun and a lack of water send you to the Medical Tent.

6 THE BEER RELAY

Teams of four run an obstacle course through the NITC campgrounds chugging beer. The winners will be celebrated on the Toyota Main Stage during the concerts.

7 TOURNAMENT OF CHAMPIONS

Free-to-play professionally run tournaments on a massive playing field. King Kong Beer Pong. Cornhole. Fowling. Which game will make you a champion?

8 EXTREME BULL RIDING

Saddle up for Extreme Bull Riding on Saturday from 12 PM – 2:30 PM with 25 world-class riders vs. 25 extreme bulls. See the map on page 28 for directions.

9 THE SAMPLING BOX

This festival extra is located inside our VIP tent because it will make you feel like a VIP. It features full-bodied cigars, the smoothest whiskeys, craft beers, and the finest wines. Friday, July 23rd from 11am to 1pm.

DON'T DO IT IN THE COUNTRY

NO UNDERAGE DRINKING

Night in the Country has a zero tolerance policy towards underage drinking. Anyone found in possession of an alcoholic beverage without a 21+ wristband will be removed from the festival grounds and will face criminal charges including up to a \$1,000 fine.

2 NO COUNTRY CRUIZIN'

Once you park your vehicle, leave it parked. Anyone found driving in the campgrounds with passengers in the bed of their truck will be ticketed. Personal off-road vehicles are not allowed in the campgrounds including: golf carts, gators, motorcycles, ATVs, etc.

3 VEHICLE RE-ENTRY

Campground vehicles will only be allowed to re-enter their campsite within the following time frames: Thursday 8 AM to 12 AM, Friday 8 AM to 7 PM, and Saturday 8 AM to 7 PM.

- 4. NO CHARCOAL BBQS
- 5 CONCERT VENUE CLEAR BAG POLICY

No backpacks, large purses, camera bags, or coolers are allowed in the Concert Venue. Approved bags are clear bags 12" x 6" X 12", standard one gallon disposable freezer bags, clear fanny packs, small clutches and purses no larger than 5" x 8". Details on page 19.

6 NO POOLS OVER 2,000 GALLONS

Due to Health Department regulations, no single pool may be filled over 2,000 gallons.

7 NO EXTRA VEHICLE PARKING AT YOUR CAMPSITE

Only one steering wheel/trailer is allowed per campsite. All other vehicles must be parked in Parking Lot B area located by the Northern Silent campground.

- 9 NO LITTERING





PATRON SAFETY

VEHICLE & RV SEARCHES

All vehicles will be searched upon entry. Please take a moment to review the camping guidelines to ensure your entry into the festival goes smoothly.

PROHIBITED ITEMS MAY BE SURRENDERED AND ARE CONSIDERED FORFEITED UPON ENTRY THROUGH THE TOLLBOOTHS.

- Any surrendered items will not be returned regardless of whether or not a receipt is provided and/or statements are made by any event personnel.
- You may elect to exit the tollbooth search prior to entering the campgrounds instead of surrendering any items.

CAMPGROUND GUIDELINES

- · NO weapons of any kind
- · NO focused light devices (laser pointers) or light beam devices
- · NO medical or recreational marijuana, illegal drugs, or drug paraphernalia
- NO golf carts, motorized conveyances, off road vehicles, autonomous vehicles
- · NO tiki torches, fuel operated lanterns, fireworks, incendiary devices
- NO charcoal BBQs or fire pits
- · NO paint, markers, flyers, stickers, or posters
- NO drones
- NO axes or hatchets
- · NO pets

THESE ITEMS ARE WELCOME FOR CAMPING:

- Dinner knives & small steak knives
- Small camping pocket knives
- Small glass condiment jars
- Small glass mixing bowls / cooking bowls
- Camping cooking utensils
- · Propane grills, gas BBQs and pellet BBQ's

ALCOHOL LIMITS UPON ENTRY FOR PATRONS 21 AND OVER

- Each patron who is 21 and over is allowed to bring in two (2) bulk items of beer or malt beverage and one (1) plastic handle of hard alcohol.
- A bulk item is defined as one (1) case (36 cans) of beer or malt beverage or one
 (1) 4 liter box of wine. Hard alcohol is one (1) 1.75 liter plastic bottle of hard alcohol.
- · NO KEGS ALLOWED
- · NO GLASS BOTTLES

CONCERT VENUE & FULL MOON SALOON GUIDELINES

All patrons will be searched upon entry into the Concert Venue and Full Moon Saloon.

PROHIBITED ITEMS:

- · NO weapons of any kind, including pocket knives
- · NO coolers
- NO backpacks
- NO large purses
- · NO camera bags
- · NO outside food, beverages, or flasks
- No video cameras or recording devices
- NO laser pointers

ALLOWED ITEMS

- Clear bags no larger than 12" x 6" X 12"
- Standard one gallon disposable freezer bags
- Small clutches or purses no larger than 5" x 8"
- Clear fanny packs
- Still cameras
- Standard size lawn chairs inside the designated lawn chair area

LAWS OF THE LAND

SAFE & SECURE

- Glass Bottles are PROHIBITED
- You must have a General Admission pass or higher to enter the campgrounds and the Full Moon Saloon.
- Don't forget your ID! You may be asked to show it to security.
- WEAPONS OF ANY KIND ARE NOT ALLOWED. If you are caught, you will be asked to leave the premises.
- Vehicles and RVs will be searched upon entry. Please visit our website for a list of what is allowed and what is not.

A BURNING RING OF FIRE

Attention all Campers: The Yerington/Mason Valley Fire Department has asked us to let you know that fire danger is extreme in the campgrounds!

BECAUSE OF THAT:

- Each campsite must have a 5 gallon bucket of water on hand
- Camp trailers and campers must have a fire extinguisher in addition to a 5-gallon bucket of water
- NO campfires allowed
- NO fireworks/sparklers allowed
- NO fuel-operated lanterns allowed
- NO tiki torches allowed
- NO Charcoal BBQs or fire pits allowed
- NO Chinese Lanterns

MEDICAL UNIT LOCATION: The medical unit is located within the emergency service compound.

Medical Unit Services: The medical unit is capable of providing first aid, emergency care, and other health services for INJURIES AND ILLNESSES THAT OCCUR AT THE EVENT. The unit is staffed with a physician, EMTs, and Paramedics.

MEDICAL EMERGENCIES: For serious medical emergencies, response vehicles and ambulances are available on-site. Contact security or staff for non-lifethreatening emergencies. 911 can be used for more serious emergencies.


